

## CAMPING

### RV/Trailer

- 4 RV / Trailer sites.
- Each space is approx. 20' x 30'.
- Must be self contained.
- (Hookups planned for summer 2010.)



### Swimming

- Newly restored 30'x 60' swimming pool available for seasonal use.
- Swimming is at your own risk.
- Release of Liability Form must be signed.
- All children under the age of 18 must be supervised by an adult at all times.
- Pool hours will be posted by the camp host.



### Fishing at Lake Cuyamaca

- Half mile—easy walk to the lake.
- Bring your own fishing gear or rent what you need at the lake.
- Boat rentals are available.
- Fishing License can be purchased at the lake.

## HIKING TRAILS

- Cuyamaca Rancho State Park has over 100 miles of trails.
- 2 mile walk/drive to Paso Picacho.
- Sunrise or sunset hike up Stonewall Peak originating at Paso Picacho.
- 8 miles to Green Valley where there are seasonal pools and waterfalls.



### Local Attractions

- **Lake Cuyamaca:** Restaurant & Store
- **Cuyamaca Rancho State Park:** Visitor Center is a 5 mile drive
- **Julian:** The nearby town with mining history, shops and world famous apple pies is a 15 minute drive.

### Tents/Primitive Camping

- 5 sites with water close by.
- A short walk to the tent site from parking.
- Porta-Pottys with hand washing units.
- Includes a picnic table.



**DIRECTIONS TO  
CAMP WOLAHI**

**From Highway 8**

Take the CA -79 / JAPATUL RD exit, EXIT 40,  
toward JULIAN

Turn NORTH onto CA—79 / JAPATUL  
VALLEY RD. Continue to follow CA-79.

Turn LEFT to stay on CA—79. (11.9 miles)

(Past Lake Cuyamaca Store)

Turn LEFT onto WOLAHI RD

**From Julian**

Turn RIGHT onto CA-79 South. (8.4 miles)

Turn RIGHT onto WOLAHI RD.

(If you reach the Lake Cuyamaca Store, you  
have passed Wolahi Rd.)

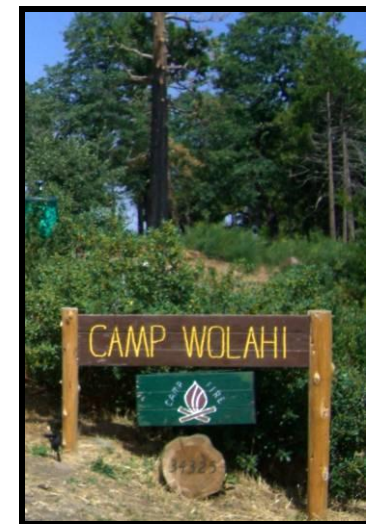
